Regular Council Meeting

Mayor called the meeting to order. The clerk was asked to call the roll, Council Members Casey Whitman, George Ragland, Levoneia Ayers, Marvelene Freeman and Mayor Mary Caudle. Members present constituted a quorum. Council member Zach Atchley was absent.

Attorney Caleb Ballew was present via Face Time and the clerk Sharron Humphrey was also present.

Motion by Ragland to approve the minutes dated March 23, 2020, Ayers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Caudle's Report: Presented Fair Housing Proclamation for the month of April to go grant paperwork.

Motion by Ragland to approve the Fair Housing Proclamation, Ayers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Finance: Chairperson Ayers presented the Bank Statement ending March 30, 2020.

Motion by Ayers to approve the Bank Statement, Ragland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Caudle reported that the pickup truck and trailer have been purchased; truck will be taken to have lights put on next week.

Park & Recreation: Chairperson Freeman asked Mayor Caudle has she received any quote on the field goal post.

Mayor stated no she hasn't but will follow up on it. She stated she received an email with pictures of spot that needs to be leveled off, plans to talk with Steve.

Ms. Freeman made the suggestion to order signs for Covid-19 to post at the parks since it's closed.

Mayor Caudle stated Chief has already posted signage indicating park is closed and he's also taped area off.

Councilman Ragland asked how can Triana kids get involved when he (Mr. Haywood) already has his team.

Mayor Caudle stated he has not released any paper forms to sign up, still working on putting out notices for anyone who wants to get involved or participate. He is trying to get the word out to more people.

Councilman Ragland stated he is concerned kids in Triana will not participating.

Utility: No Report

Fire & Police: Mayor Caudle reported the Fire Dept., logged 2,695 miles, made 42 traffic stops, 42 warning citations, 4 citations, 54 calls for service, 0 arrest and 9 reports.

Streets & Cemetery: Chairperson Whitman reported he contacted Huntsville Engineer Dept. this morning; 6th Street is back under water. Since that part of the street is in Huntsville the City engineer has to come out and take a look at it.
Tornado shelter never really opened storm passed.

RESOLUTIONS, ORDINANCES, ORDERS AND OTHER BUSINESS:

Attorney Caleb reported he has reviewed the sewer agreement which he found to be a standard agreement. He would encourage council to get them the right spec so they won't go against our code and we can catch mistakes early on. They have submitted copies of their insurance. As requested.

Contacted Brian Williams, they will be doing some tract changes to town's junk ordinance. Plan to leave the enforcement to the executive judicial branch.

Motion by Ragland to change the regular council meeting date in May to the 26th and in October to the 13th, Whitman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Ms. Freeman asked Mayor Caudle when to submit work orders for town employees; they have not been picking up the trash on Ervin Lane.

Ms. Ayers stated she has seen the workers picking up on 6th Street.

Mayor Caudle stated she will make sure they pick up on all streets.

Roy Seay stated when funds become available he would like to see Landess Cir widened.



WHEREAS, the month of April is recognized throughout these United States of America as Fair Housing Month; and

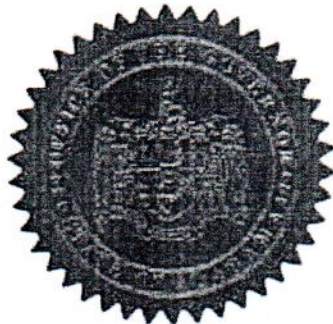
