

**Town of Triana
Regular Council Meeting
Monday, February 24, 2020
6:30p.m.**

The Mayor called the meeting to order. The clerk was asked to call the roll, Council Members Casey Whitman, George Ragland, Marvelene Freeman, Zach Atchley and Mayor Mary Caudle. Members present constituted a quorum. Council member Levoneia Ayers was absent.

Legal counsel Caleb Ballew and the clerk Sharron Humphrey were also present.

Motion by Whitman to approve the minutes dated Feb. 10, 2020, Ragland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mayor Caudle's Report: Met with architect to discuss samples for gym.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Fire & Police: Chairperson Atchley reported the Police Officers logged 781 miles, made 23 traffic stops, 23 warning citations, and 5 citations, 15 calls for service, 1 arrest and 5 reports.

Councilman Ragland asked for an update on patrol car.

Mayor Caudle reported patrol car should be here any day now, the new one is still being worked on per discussion with County Commissioner on Tuesday of last week. They are still working to finalize budget for fiscal year.

Councilman Ragland asked what the new Officers salary was.

Mayor stated if and when the new officer passes and finish the academy he will receive the salary council agreed on.

Ragland made a motion to pay the new Police Officer \$19.00 per hr. starting today, motion died for lack of second.

Utility: Chairperson Ragland reported lift station in Bingo parking lot needs to be repaired and that Old Chicken shack needs a commercial meter.

Mayor stated she approved for Madison Utilities to put a new meter in on last week. She also stated town workers have been going out changing and replacing bad meters.

Ragland stated we don't have to wait on Madison to repair the lift station we can get someone else to repair it.

Council woman Freeman stated if Madison cannot come out to fix lift station why we can't hire a private contractor to do the work.

Mayor Caudle stated Madison did not say they can't do the work council has agreed to have her negotiate a contract for them start on the first phase of the sewer system, repairing the lift station is included.

Mayor stated if council wants to go outside the first phase we can hire someone else to make the repair.

Freeman asked the attorney is the council not obligated to provide service to businesses here in Triana.

Attorney Caleb stated yes to any tax paying citizen or business entity.

Park & Recreation: Mayor was asked to give update on gym project. She will meet with architect on tomorrow to pick out colors samples. They have installed water line for the handicap bathroom.

Streets & Cemetery: No Report

Resolutions, Ordinances, Orders and Other Business

Motion by Whitman to leave the qualifying fee at \$50.00 for Mayor and \$25.00 for Council, Ragland seconded the motion. Roll call vote, Whitman-yes, Ragland-yes, Atchley-yes, Freeman-yes and Caudle-yes. Unanimous consent motion carried.

Motion by Whitman to pay the election workers: Clerks-\$150.00, Inspector \$250.00 and the Election Manager \$200.00, Atchley seconded the motion. Roll call vote Whitman-yes, Ragland-no, Atchley-yes, Freeman-yes and Caudle-yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Whitman to consider Ordinance 2020-04 salary for Mayor \$750.00 and \$500.00 for council, Ragland seconded the motion. Roll call vote Whitman-yes, Ragland-yes, Atchley-no, Freeman-no and Caudle-yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Whitman to adopt Ordinance 2020-04 salary for Mayor and Council, Ragland seconded the motion. Roll call vote Whitman-yes, Ragland-yes, Atchley-no, Freeman-no and Caudle-yes. Motion carried.

Attorney Caleb Ballew reported a city can allow a retired officer to have his service weapon and badge as a part of his retirement package, he cannot be extra compensated and the city has to have a written policy in place at the time of retirement.
Mayor Caudle asked Attorney Ballew to help draft a letter to retired officer regarding this decision.

Councilman Ragland stated the town needs to purchase a pickup truck the one we have is not safe to drive. He purchased tires for the truck six months ago and now those are worn out.
Freeman stated she agrees with Mr. Ragland on that.
Ragland also stated we need to have the 1.6 acre of land appraised on Record and Stone Street.
Mayor stated council has agreed to use last appraisal done on the property.

Ragland suggested council have a work session to discuss land on Record and Stone Street, decide whether to sell the easement it or give it away.
Work session scheduled 30minutes before next regular council meeting to discuss how town will proceed with easement.

Public Comments:

Joe Bell a lifelong resident of Triana expressed his concern over why Town closed road leading to the boat dock. He stated other surrounding cities did not close their boat dock why did Triana?
Mayor stated the County came out and did an assessment of area.
Freeman suggested we purchase signs warning motorist.
Mayor stated we will order warning signs warning motorist of high water.

Calvin Rogers stated water from the rain is surrounding his home he asked if town could have it pumped like last time when the water was that high.

Mayor stated last time she got permission from the land owners to go across their property she will work on that.

Sarah Rogers asked the council could they be proactive so they won't have the same problem every time it rains a lot she stated she has health issues and grandkids that likes to play outside but can't because of the water near their house.

Mayor stated we could look at digging a trench; she will get with all parties owning property in that area.
