A RESOLUTION OPPOSING SCHOOL START DATE LEGISLATION

WHEREAS, students within the Town of Triana attend Madison City Schools through agreement between the Town of Triana, and the City of Madison Board of Education; and


WHEREAS, The City of Madison Board of Education has recently resolved their opposition to School Start Date Legislation via City of Madison Board of Education Resolution #20-01; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Triana concurs with the same Resolution and places its trust in the judgment of the City of Madison Board of Education in establishing a school calendar that best meets the needs of the students and families within the Town of Triana and City of Madison, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Triana unequivocally opposes statewide efforts to mandate a school calendar and ask all lawmakers representing Madison City School System to vote against any bill which proposes to outline a statewide start and/or end date for Alabama public schools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be provided to the Madison City School Board, the City of Madison, each member of its Legislative delegation and the Governor.
